

Dress Standards and Players Etiquette

Home & Away Roster Matches + Preliminary Finals:

Neat Casual - Dress Trousers, Jeans, Polo Top, Shirt with Collar, Dress Shoes, Sandshoes

Grand Final:

Dress Trousers (dark colour), Dress Shoes (dark), Dress Shirt, Bow Tie and Vest (optional) Or

Dress Trousers (dark colour), Dress Shoes (dark), Polo Top (If Team Name on Polo Top and all Players must be wearing the same Team Polo Top)

Representative Matches:

Dress Trousers (dark colour), Dress Shoes (dark), White Dress Shirt, Bow Tie, NTB&SA Playing Vest while playing

Billiards & Snooker Championships Matches:

Round Robin Matches: Neat Casual – Dress Trousers, Jeans, Polo Top, Shirt with Collar, Dress Shoes, Sandshoes

Billiards & Snooker Championships Quarter, Semi and Final:

Dress Trousers (dark colour), Dress Shoes (dark), Dress Shirt, Bow Tie and Vest (optional)

6 Red Snooker Championship:

Dress Trousers (dark colour), Dress Shoes (dark), Polo Top or Shirt with Collar

Order of Play

Allies to be drawn to determine order of play The 2 lowest handicap players will be drawn first (1 and 2) and then the next 2 players on handicap (3 and 4)

Breaks in Between Frames:

Captains and Players are reminded that they should be ready to play the next frame once the referee has set the table for the start of the next frame

This means that a player would have about a 3 minute break from the end of the frame until the start of the next frame

Mobile Phones:

Players should put their phones on silent when playing and unless there is an emergency call not answer a call during a frame and definitely not start a conversation on their phone while the other player is addressing the table.

Referees Decisions:

Players should not argue with the referee on decisions made

Neutral Area: (LWC)

Only Players and the Referee to be at the scoring end of the table (Score Board) Players not playing are asked to stay away from this end and not to engage in conversation with the referee and the non-striker
