2011 TASMANIAN JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

The 2011 Tasmanian Junior Snooker and Billiards Championships will be hosted by the Northern Tasmanian Billiards and Snooker Association at the Launceston Workers Club, Elizabeth Street, during the weekend of March 26-27.

Championships will be held in the following divisions:

Billiards: 8-12 years, 12-15 years and 15-18 years

Snooker: 8-12 years, 12-15 years and 15-18 years

Junior Women's Snooker: 8-18 years

1. PLAYING CONDITIONS

All matches will be played at the time and on the tables as stated in the programme. Players must be present at the venue at least 30 minutes prior to the start of their match and report to the Tournament Director or Referee presiding over the match.

All matches, snooker and billiards, will be timed. Three-frame snooker matches will be limited to 1.5 hours (90 minutes) of play. Five-frame snooker matches will be limited to 2.5 hours (150 minutes), with a break of five (5) minutes after frame three.

Preliminary billiards matches will be limited to thirty (30) minutes. The finals of each billiards section will be sixty (60) minutes (one hour), with a break of five (5) minutes after 30 minutes.

The top two from each division will advance to the finals. The following formula applies:

SNOOKER: Matches won against matches lost; frames won against frames lost; aggregate scores.

BILLIARDS: Matches won against matches lost; aggregate scores.

2. DRESS CODE

In line with all tournaments conducted under the auspices of the Tasmanian Billiards and Snooker Association, a dress code applies. **The minimum requirement is:** Long sleeved shirt or blouse of one colour, tie (preferably a bow tie), slacks/trousers (black or grey) and black shoes. Vests, if players choose to wear them, are optional. **Ties must be worn at all times when playing.**

ALL PLAYERS are requested to familiarise themselves with the Dress Code. Violations of the Dress Code may result in penalties being imposed on the offending player.

3. TRAVEL AND ACCOMMODATION

Travelling arrangements and accommodation, if required, will be the responsibility of the individual. Accommodation may be available at the **Colonial Motor Inn** (just up the road), a five-minute walk from the venue.

4. LEAVING THE VENUE

NO PLAYER SHALL LEAVE THE VENUE WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND/OR ORGANISERS.

As the TBSA and NTBSA are responsible for the safety and welfare of the players involved in Junior competitions, this condition is **NOT NEGOTIABLE**.

Failure to adhere to this condition may result in a player being excluded from the remainder of the tournament.

5. CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES

Nominations will be accepted up until close of business at **6 pm on Friday, March 18, 2011**.
LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED OR CONSIDERED. **The onus is on the player.**

Entries may be made by post, phone or email **BUT** the completed entry form must be handed in to the organisers before the start of play on March 26.
